



Easter Fast Approaching at San Joaquin County Parks

San Joaquin County Parks is ready for Easter! Before guests arrive, here's some quick reminders.

Micke Grove and Oak Grove regional parks will be open from 7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (gates close at 7 p.m.) and will limit entrance into the parks on Easter Sunday (maximum 1,200 vehicles at Micke Grove and 350 vehicles at Oak Grove). **Parking will be \$10 per vehicle, tickets will not be accepted for park re-entry and no refunds** will be issued. Please note, cash is the only form of payment at Oak Grove while cash and ATM/credit card are acceptable at Micke Grove (a second gate will be open during peak hours and will be cash only). **Parking will only be allowed in marked parking spaces**, vehicles may not unload or park on the lawn. **Masks will be required at all times** for guests over the age of two years.

Camping and day-use at Stillman Magee Regional Park remain closed. Rafters floating down the Mokelumne River can still disembark at Stillman Magee, **as the parking area is available for loading and unloading from 8 AM to 30 min. before sunset.** Please contact East Bay Municipal Utility District prior to arrival as river access may be closed due to increased flows, they can be reached at (209) 772-8204. **Parking fees still apply** (\$10 per vehicle on Easter Sunday).

As a reminder, **Micke Grove Zoo will be open during normal operating hours** (10 a.m. to 5 p.m., gates close at 4:30 p.m.) **and will be limited to 25% capacity.** Additionally, **all outdoor picnic shelters, boat rentals and water features at Micke Grove and Oak Grove regional parks remain closed** due to COVID-19, and **disc golf courses at both parks will be closed for the day** (Fun Town and the San Joaquin County Historical Museum will remain closed at Micke Grove, while the Nature Center will remain shuttered at Oak Grove). **First-come, first-serve picnic tables will be available and first-come rules will apply** (this includes no trailer BBQs, bounce houses, amplified sound, generators and water apparatuses). As with every visit, guests are required to clean up their areas, use trash receptacles and refrain from using materials such as confetti, glitter, etc. **Guests are required to adhere to all guidelines, violators will be asked to leave.**

Guests are advised to remain home if sick or unwell and practice social distancing to prevent COVID-19. **Park closures may be reinstated if social distancing protocols are not followed.** For more information, please visit our website at www.sjpark.com or our Facebook or Instagram account.
