



Staying physically active is one of the best ways to keep your mind and body healthy. In many areas, people can visit parks, trails and open spaces as a way to relieve stress, get fresh air and vitamin D, stay active and safely connect with others.

As a result, **San Joaquin County Parks and Recreation will begin to re-open some regional and community parks beginning Monday, May 18, 2020.**

Due to COVID-19, **the Parks Division will be enforcing social distancing restrictions** aimed at keeping park guests and employees safe and healthy.

The current order implemented by the San Joaquin County Public Health Officer requires adhering to the rules of social distancing, avoiding gatherings and staying at home whenever possible. **Park closures may be reinstated if social distancing protocols are not followed.**

DO's

- ✓ Visit parks that are close to your home.
- ✓ Stay home if you are sick or do not feel well.
- ✓ Prepare for your visit by checking the San Joaquin County Parks website, www.sjparks.com for the latest information on open and closed amenities.
- ✓ Stay at least six feet away from others (“social distancing”) and take other steps to prevent COVID-19.
- ✓ Read posted signs and obey all park rules.

DON'T's

- ✗ Visit parks if you are sick or were recently exposed to COVID-19.
- ✗ Participate in organized activities or sports.
- ✗ Gather with others outside of your household.
- ✗ Use any restricted or closed amenities.
- ✗ No bounce houses, amplified sound, BBQ's, generators, kiddie pools, tables or chairs.
