



MICKE GROVE ZOO NOW OPEN!

Gatherings still prohibited at County parks due to COVID-19

Micke Grove Zoo is now open! The zoo is open daily from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (last entry at 4 p.m.), and open Wednesdays through Sundays beginning in November. Cost is \$5 adults, \$3 age 13 – 3, free for children age 2 and under. **Zoo Annual Passes are now available**, including for seniors and active military members. Applications can be found online on our website.

Social gatherings are still prohibited at all San Joaquin County Parks due to COVID-19. Any gatherings must remain within a single household and all first-come, first-serve rules apply, including **no tables or chairs, bounce houses, amplified sound, water apparatuses, trailer BBQ's or generators.**

Micke Grove and Oak Grove regional parks are open 8 AM to 5 PM daily. Day-use facilities at Dos Reis, Westgate Landing and Mossdale Crossing regional parks are available from 8 AM until 30 minutes before sunset. Micke Grove's Japanese Garden is open during its regular operating hours. **All playgrounds, along with Fun Town, Oak Grove Nature Center, Regional Sports Complex, Harmony Grove Church and Woodbridge Wilderness Area, remain closed.**

Camping and day-use at Stillman Magee Regional Park remain closed. Rafters floating down the Mokelumne River can still disembark at Stillman Magee, **as the parking area is available for loading and unloading from 8 AM to 30 min. before sunset. Parking fees still apply** (\$5 weekends, \$6 weekends and most holidays and \$10 special holidays).

Camping at Dos Reis and Westgate Landing regional parks is by reservation-only through the Parks Administrative Office, located inside Micke Grove Regional Park. **Reservations are accepted from 8 AM to 4:15 PM Monday through Friday and can be made either by credit card at (209) 953-8800 or in person at the office, 11793 N. Micke Grove Rd., Lodi.** Due to COVID-19, **there is a 10-day maximum stay at Dos Reis & Westgate Landing regional parks.**

Guests are advised to remain home if sick or unwell and practice social distancing to prevent COVID-19. **Park closures may be reinstated if social distancing protocols are not followed.**
