San Joaquin County Disabled Veteran/Prisoner of War Annual Pass Program

Qualified war veterans are eligible to receive a Disabled Veteran/Prisoner of War Annual Pass free of charge, which entitles the holder to San Joaquin County Regional Park <u>day use and parking</u> at no charge. The pass is valid for 12 months from the date of issuance. The annual pass is not valid for facility reservations, camping, second vehicle fees, zoo admission fees, museum admission fees or any other supplemental fees offered by San Joaquin County. In order to qualify for an Annual Pass, the veteran must be a California resident and provide:

- 1. A certificate from the Veterans Administration stating that the veteran was honorably discharged and that the wartime disability is service-connected and rated at 50%, or a service-connected disability rated at 100% for reasons of unemployability; or a letter of certification from the Veterans Administration or copy of personnel records from the appropriate military branch, verifying prisoner of war status and honorable discharge (DD214 or Report of Separation); *AND*
- 2. A copy of his/her California Driver License or Identification Card as proof of California residency.

All certification material will be retained by the San Joaquin County Department of Parks and Recreation and will not be returned.

Once the Annual Pass is issued, it:

- Is valid for 12 months from the date of issuance and is valid for day use and parking fees at any San Joaquin County Regional Park, any day of the week, including holidays. All parking is on a first come first serve basis when parking is available.
- If the entrance kiosk is not manned, but the park is open, display your pass from your rear view mirror.
- Is non transferable. Upon suitable proof, a lost or damaged pass may be replaced.
- Will always be necessary for you to show your Annual Pass when entering or parking in a San Joaquin County Regional Park.
